Most recently, the Force 94 Boys won the 2006 STYSA Super II State Championship. In the 2006-07 seasonal year, Force teams posted a cumulative winning record against all other Austin area clubs!

Fees

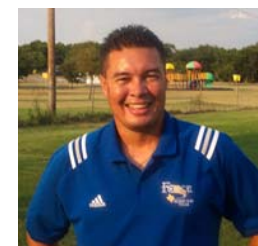
The Force Program is committed to providing a high-quality experience while recognizing the financial burden that comes with select sports. Our fee structure takes this into account.

The training and registration fees for all divisions of play will be \$800 for the seasonal year (Fall & Spring) plus tournament and uniform costs. Fees are paid incrementally at registration and over several months during the Fall season. The base uniform cost* will be \$110 and tournament costs are typically \$20-30 per player per tournament. * *Returning player will not need a new uniform.*

Our low overhead costs allow us to provide a quality product at a lower price than any other club in the area. We urge you to compare our fees in relation to your individual needs, while keeping in mind that higher pricing doesn't necessarily equate to a better product when it comes to select soccer.

Coaching

Our Coaching Staff has a combination of national licensing, college & professional playing & coaching experience, and years of experience training youth soccer players. All teams will be assigned a qualified trainer who will conduct age appropriate training activities for his/her team, following an overall training curriculum established by the Director of Coaching. Trainers are also present on the sidelines of their team's games along with the parent coach of the team. Specialized goalkeeper training is provided by a designated Keeper Trainer. Supplemental private training may also be provided as needed or requested for an additional fee.

A Georgetown native and long time Force Trainer, Richard brings a wealth of experience and a true passion for the game of soccer. A former U.S. Marine, Richard also holds a degree in Exercise Sports Science from Texas

State University, and is a teacher in the Round Rock School District. Richard's training and teaching experience, as well as his commitment to providing a competitive yet fun soccer experience has helped him develop a quality competitive program at GSA. Richard Holds a USSF National "C" coaching license and the "National Youth" License from USSF.

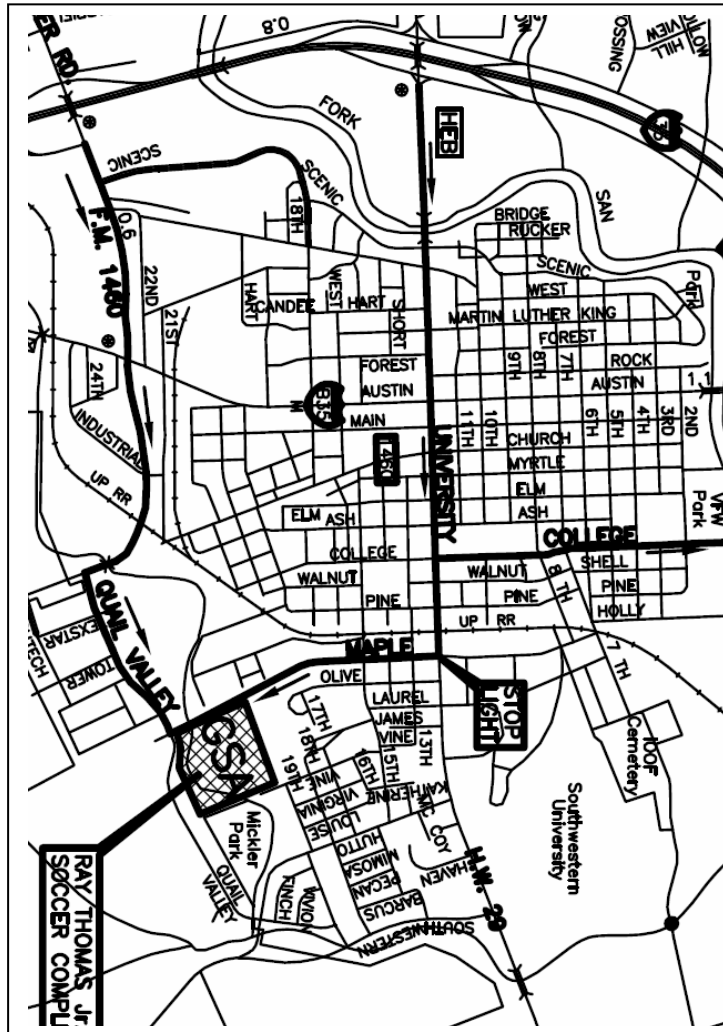
